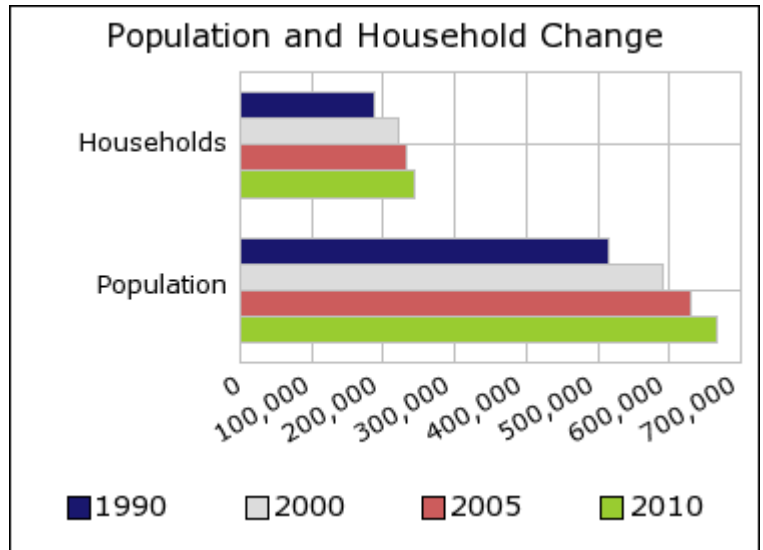

Population Demographics:

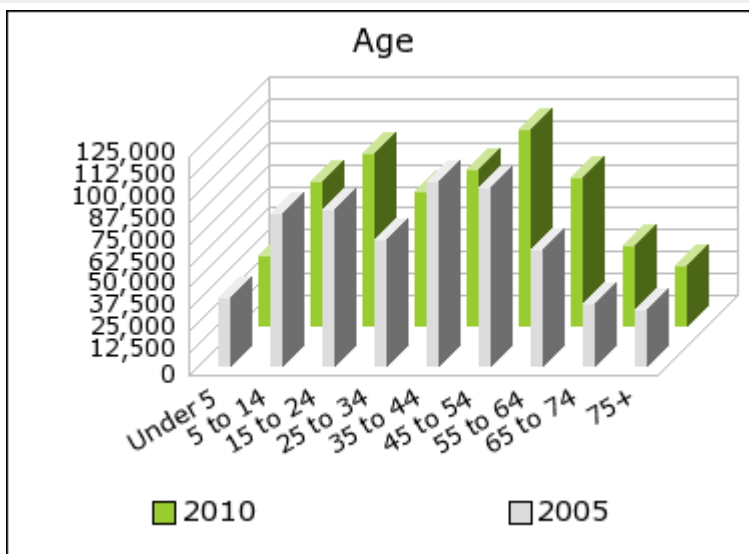
The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **186,859** and changed to **219,911** in 2000, representing a change of **17.7%**. The household count in 2005 was **232,743** and the household projection for 2010 is **244,938**, a change of **5.2%**.

The population in the study area in 1990 was **516,463** and in 2000 it was **590,443**, roughly a **14.3%** change. The population in 2005 was **629,008** and the projection for 2010 is **665,141** representing a change of **5.7%**.

Population by Age



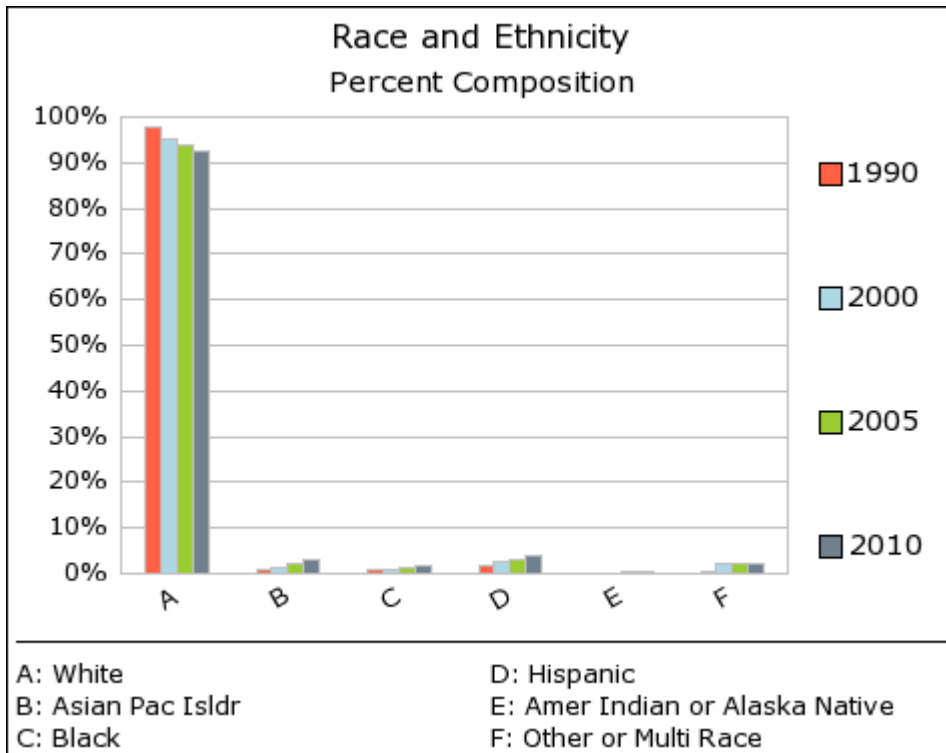
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **32.0**, and in 2000, it was **36.0**. The median age in 2005 is **37.9** and it is predicted to change in five years to **39.5** years. In 2005, females represented **50.8%** of the population with a median age of **38.6** and males represented **49.2%** of the population with a median age of **37.1** years. Population by Race/Ethnicity



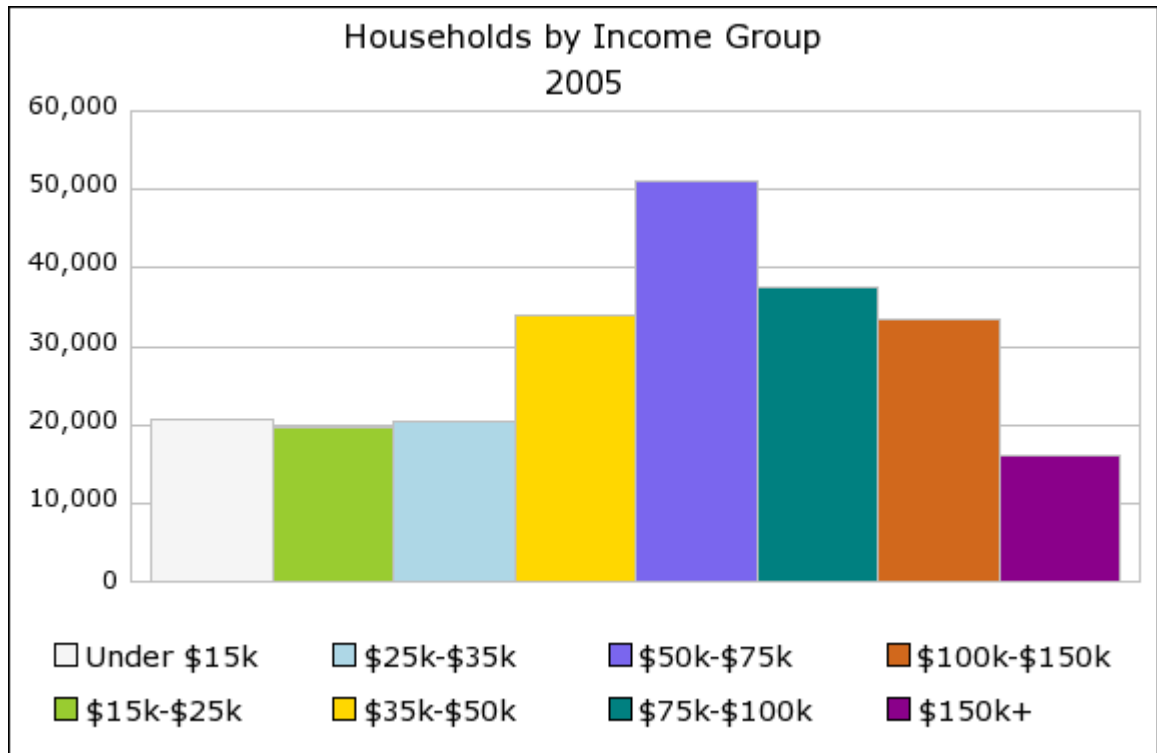
